

## REGULATIONS 2026

Registration and participation in the Land Party 2026 implies acceptance of these regulations. Each participant must accept, respect and follow these rules for the benefit of all other participants, the environment and the smooth running of the activity.

### PREAMBLE

---

The Land Party is a concentration of Land Rover brand vehicles that takes place on September 25, 26 and 27, 2026 at the "Les Comes" estate in the town of Súria (Barcelona). This activity is of a playful-festive nature, it is not in any case a competition or sports event.

### INSCRIPTION

---

Participants can pre-register either through the [www.landparty.es](http://www.landparty.es) website or by presenting themselves at "Les Comes" during the same weekend of the concentration. Registration will be formalized at the time that the organization indicates to the participant their assigned bib number.

Pre-registration through the official website will open in June 2026 and will remain open online until September 20, 2026. From this moment on, registrations can only be processed on-site in Les Comes during the same weekend of the event within the following established hours, Friday from 09:00h to 21:00h, Saturday from 9:00h to 19:00h, and Sunday from 9:00h to 14:00h.

### PRICES

---

#### CONCEPT "PARTICIPANT"

- Land Rover vehicle user who wants to access the 4x4 routes and tracks of Les Comes with the car.
- Participant prices include access to a vehicle and a driver.
- Only Land Rover vehicle users can register as participants and access tracks.

#### CONCEPT "COMPANION"

- People who are inside a vehicle participating except for the driver (maximum 4 pax. per vehicle). They must pay Les Comes the amount corresponding to their ticket on site.

#### CONCEPT "VISITOR"

- People without a Land Rover vehicle or who do not want to access the route and the 4x4 tracks, but who have access to the rest of the activities of the event.

## PRICES FOR COMPANIONS AND VISITORS

Visitor/companion prices include the 3 days of the event (Friday, Saturday and Sunday):

<b>FREE</b>	<b>Age 3 or younger.</b>
<b>10€</b>	<b>From 4 to 10 years old.</b>
<b>15€</b>	<b>Over 10 years old and adults.</b>

- Visitor and companion tickets are sold at Les Comes on the same day of the event.
- Companions are people who are inside a participant's vehicle.
- Visitors are people who do not want to access the 4x4 slopes with their Land Rover or who do not have a vehicle of the brand but want to enjoy the rest of the activities.

## CAMPING PRICE

**EXTRA CAMPING PRICE: 50€\***

\*Includes the night from Thursday to Friday and from Sunday to Monday.

### **IMPORTANT:**

- The 2-3 day online registration includes camping for one vehicle and one tent.
- From the 2nd "vehicle" onwards, 40€/vehicle\* must be paid on the same day of the event.

\* "Vehicle" is understood to be caravans, cars, 4x4, motorhomes, trailers, Comanches and any other type of vehicle or equipment that occupies a space in the camping area.

- Participants have priority for camping. Visitors to the camp are only accepted if space is still available on the day of the event.
- The organization will decide if there is space left or not in this area.
- All vehicles with a length of more than 7.5 metres, as well as trucks, cranes, gondolas, etc., should consult the organisation before entering the camping area.

### **IMPORTANT:**

- Visitor and participant tickets are nominative. In no case may they be sold or assigned to another person.
- An identification bracelet will be provided to each of the participants, companions and visitors, who will give access to the facilities and activities.
- Most of the event's activities are included in the ticket price. however, some of them must be paid with cashless within the Les Comes venue.

### **Not included in the price:**

- Any type of catering service (restaurant, bar, drinks, etc.).
- No products from the merchandising store (unless otherwise specified by the organization)
- Some unspecified activities.

Visitors and/or people who do not have a Land Rover vehicle must leave the vehicle in the car park provided for them and will access the facilities and activities on foot.

Visitors and/or people who do not have a Land Rover vehicle will NOT be able to participate in activities that require the express use of the vehicle (driving on tracks, driving school, etc...).

## 2.1 IDENTIFICATION

Each of the people who are inside the Les Comes venue during the event must wear the BRACELET that the Organization has provided.

The BRACELET must be worn correctly on the wrist. Broken bracelets, bracelets in the hand, or bracelets that are not correctly placed will not be accepted. Any person who does not wear this bracelet or who does not provide documentary proof of having paid the Registration/Ticket Price, must immediately pay the corresponding price or assume immediate exclusion from the Les Comes venue and the Event. This bracelet will give access to the facilities and activities allowed by these Regulations for each type of registration/ticket, provided that the schedule and program provided by the organization are respected.

Each of the vehicles that is inside the Les Comes venue during the event must carry the STICKER that the Organization has provided and that corresponds to it, depending on the activity it is carrying out or the location where it is at the time of identification. By way of example; the vehicles in the Camping Area must have the corresponding sticker.

The driver of the vehicle that does not carry this Sticker or who does not provide documentary evidence of having paid the Registration/Ticket Price, must immediately pay the corresponding price or assume the immediate exclusion from the Les Comes venue and the Event. This sticker will give access to the facilities and activities allowed by these Regulations for each type of registration/ticket, provided that the schedule and program provided by the organization are respected.

## VEHICLES

Any Land Rover brand vehicle can register for the Land Party and access the tracks.

\*Entries will NOT be accepted under any circumstances from vehicles other than Land Rover.

\*For any questions about vehicles with access to tracks, consult the organization.

**All participating vehicles must have an up-to-date registration certificate, ITV and compulsory civil liability insurance. Likewise, within the "Les Comes" enclosure only participants who have a valid driving license will be able to drive. The vehicle must be legally allowed to circulate on public roads in Spain.**

**The original vehicle documentation and driving licence must be carried on the day of the event and the organisation reserves the right to request it at any time. In case of not having them or doubts about their validity/authenticity, the organization will have all the right to deny the participation of the vehicle or driver.**

All participating vehicles that access the slopes and that have a winch integrated into the vehicle must have a sling. If they do not carry it, they will not be allowed access to the slopes.

---

## RESPONSIBILITIES

All participants must respect and follow the instructions of the organization.

-Each participant will be responsible for any damage and/or damage that may be caused to the facilities due to misuse of the same or failure to follow the instructions of the organization. The article of the highway code in force regarding the maximum blood alcohol level allowed for the use of a vehicle will be applied, if necessary.

-The organization may deny the use of the facilities or circulation through them to a participant who does not respect the instructions of the organization.

-The participant is aware of and assumes the risks involved in taking part in some of the activities for both their vehicle and its occupants.

-Each participant is responsible for complying with the rule established by the corresponding government regarding the safety distance and the use of protective material (e.g. masks) to protect their health and that of all attendees from viral infections such as Covid-19 and any other contagious infection or disease. They must follow the instructions that the organization takes in this regard at all times and respect the corresponding posters.

-Children are under the guardianship and responsibility of their parents, also within the areas set up for them.

-Pets must be supervised, tied up and under the responsibility of their owner. Dangerous animals must wear the corresponding morion.

-The sale of products or services throughout the property is prohibited except for those that are expressly allowed by the organization.

-All participating vehicles that access tracks and that have a winch integrated into the vehicle must have a sling. If they do not carry it, they will not be allowed access to the slopes.

Participants, companions and visitors must accept and must commit to respect and comply with the EVENT REGULATIONS as well as the SAFETY REGULATIONS, RISKS AND CONDITIONS OF THE EVENT.

---

## DRIVING ON TRACKS

---

All the routes have been prepared, recognized and marked according to the type of difficulty by the organization. Because there are some tracks with stony terrain we advise checking the tyre pressures.

- The organization has the right to close access or modify the initial route for safety reasons, or due to adverse weather conditions.
- Some of the sections may be two-way, so it will be necessary to take extreme precautionary measures.
- The route signs must be respected at all times. The arrows must not be removed or changed direction, chains, fences or barbed wire that delimit an area must not be opened or closed.
- It is totally forbidden to ride outside the marked tracks and/or cross-country.
- Access to the slopes is strictly forbidden to pedestrians.
- For safety reasons, the slopes will be closed from 6:30 p.m. on Friday and Saturday and at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday. Driving on slopes at night is not allowed.

---

## CIRCULATION AROUND THE VENUE

---

The maximum speed allowed to circulate in the access areas to the facilities, parking or camping area is 10 km/h.

The maximum during the track route is 30km/h.

The circulation of vehicles, whether motorized or non-motorized, is not allowed within the estate, including the Camping Area, the tracks, the parking lots, the Commercial Area, or any other area within the venue where the event is held. This prohibition does not affect 4x4 vehicles participating in the event with an assigned bib number, nor does it affect the organisation's staff or other vehicles that have been expressly authorised. Failure to comply with this rule may lead to the expulsion of the participant or visitor who violates it.

### **Attention!**

You must drive with caution and at a safe distance of 15-20 meters from the car in front. Priority in access, camping and/or parking areas will always be pedestrians.

After 10:00 p.m. it will not be possible to circulate in the camping area. If someone arrives after the deadline, they must leave their vehicle in the car park set up by the organisation.

In no case will the Land Party organization be responsible for a traffic accident caused by a person outside it.

### **6.1 ACCIDENTS**

In the event of an accident, the participant will be responsible for the material damage that may have been caused to their vehicle.

In the event that the accident is between two or more vehicles, the usual and legal procedure will be followed, with all those involved filling out a "friendly" accident report. In no case will the organization of the "Land Party" be responsible for a traffic accident caused by a person outside it.

## ENVIRONMENT

---

It is strictly forbidden to throw any type of waste on the ground. There will be litter bins and rubbish bins distributed throughout the venue; Garbage bags will be provided to anyone who wishes to do so, which, once used, must be deposited in the authorized place (ask the organization).

Due to the proximity of a forest area, it is not allowed to make fires or the use of barbecues of any kind. Any type of activity without permission will be reported to the relevant authorities with the corresponding sanction to be paid by the person responsible for the incident.

## EXCLUSION

---

No participant is registered without a race number. If the organizers, at their own discretion, refuse to authorize a participant, the registration fee will be refunded to the same card used to make the payment.

The organization reserves the right to definitively exclude from "Land Party" any person whose behavior or conduct harms the proper functioning of the concentration, its regulations or its safety standards.

For example:

- . Dangerous and/or reckless attitude with risk to people.
- . Violent and aggressive attitude towards other participants.
- . Not respecting the regulations.
- . Not carrying the vehicle's or driver's documentation with you, or that it is not in order.
- . Ride off-road, off-road or at night on the slopes.
- . Driving around the premises while intoxicated or under the influence of drugs.
- . Failure to comply with the public health regulations of the corresponding government.

In case of being excluded from the event, the total or partial amount of the ticket will not be refunded.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

---

The refund period in case of cancellation is until September 13. From 14 September, the registration fee will not be refunded and the registration fee will not be saved for the following year.

Even so, in the event of cancellation of the event due to extraordinary causes, 100% of the registration fee will be refunded to all participants regardless of the date on which it occurs.

## CAMPING AREA

---

Les Comes offers a large camping area with toilets and showers to make your stay as comfortable as possible. You cannot camp anywhere else within the farm that is not enabled for this purpose.

The camping area has a capacity limit. As soon as the organization communicates through the official website that this area is complete, no more participants or visitors will be accepted in this area nor will it be possible to process their reservation through the website or on-site in Les Comes on the same day of the event or in any other way.

LET'S REMEMBER THAT IT IS A CAMPING AREA, IT IS NOT A CAMPSITE.

No electricity service is offered.

- The use of generators after 11:00 p.m. is prohibited
- It will not be possible to access the camping area without first having correctly registered.
- Users must generally refrain from carrying out activities that may be annoying to all campers.
- The circulation or walking of animals through the camping area is totally prohibited unless they are not properly leashed, the owner being responsible for non-compliance with this rule.
- Dangerous animals must wear the corresponding morion.
- It is forbidden within the camping area to play all kinds of games that may disturb other users.
- The use of music devices in the camping area is prohibited.
- It is forbidden to barbecue or any type of fire.
- It is forbidden to throw garbage, waste or empty the chemical toilet.

- It is strictly forbidden to wash any object other than a kitchen utensil in the dishwasher, as well as to use sinks and showers as dishwashers.

ANY FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN THE EXPULSION OF THE PEOPLE INVOLVED FROM THE PREMISES.

## ACTIVITY INSURANCE

---

The company Promotor Les Comes Special Events S.L.U, as organizer of the event, has taken out civil liability insurance No. 83450708 contracted with the insurance company Axa Seguros Generales.

---

## RIGHTS OF THE ORGANIZER

---

The organizer is not responsible for any type of accident of which the participant may be a victim or cause. The organizer reserves the right to modify aspects relating to the location of services, routes, schedules, activities, etc.

At any time, the organizer reserves the right to cancel or temporarily suspend the event, and to resolve, at its discretion, any incident that may occur in the course of the event.

If the event is cancelled due to force majeure (weather or any other type) that prevent it from being held on the indicated day, in this case the organizer will not refund the amount of the registrations.

The organizer reserves the right to change (delete, add or modify articles) of these rules by legal imposition.

The organization reserves the right of admission to the event.

---

## PROTECTION AND ASSISTANCE

---

During the event there will be the presence of vehicles and personnel of the organization suitably identified to help the proper development of the event.

The Organization will also install indicative signs, signs, arrows and place duly identified personnel in the places it deems convenient and/or possible. Most of these posters are helpful or merely informative, with the exception of those that refer to health issues or indications, in which case they will be mandatory.

The Local Police of the Municipalities, Mossos d'Esquadra and Firefighters will be informed and alerted in advance of the celebration of the event.

The Organization will have a medical service in "Les Comes" during the opening and closing hours of the routes and slopes that will be centralized and coordinated by the medical assistance service. This service will consist of doctors, nurses, ambulances and a mobile hospital and first aid service.

The General Hospital of Manresa will be duly informed in advance of the celebration of the event with a letter detailing the schedules of the event and contact person in case of emergency.

Due to the type of activity that will take place at this event, the organization warns all participants/visitors of the risks and especially people who may have back problems, asthma, heart disease or women in a possible state of pregnancy. In other words, any participant/visitor who participates in both the physical activities and the rest of the activities, does so at their own risk. Likewise, participants/visitors who may have any type of medical or food allergy or intolerance must notify the Medical Services before the event.

---

## IMAGE RIGHTS

---

The acceptance of these regulations necessarily implies that the participant authorizes the organizer of the event to record all or part of his/her participation in it, gives his/her consent for his/her image to be used for the promotion and dissemination of the image of the event in all its forms (radio, press, video, photos, DVD, internet, posters, etc.), media, etc.) and assigns all the rights related to its commercial and advertising exploitation that they deem appropriate to execute, without the right on their part to receive financial compensation.



## LOPD AND PRIVACY POLICY

---

In compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation of the E.U. 2016/679 and the Organic Law on the Protection of Personal Data, we inform you that the personal data you have provided have been freely provided and that you have been unequivocally informed about the purpose of the collection. They will be incorporated into a processing file of the company Promotor Les Comes Special Events, S.L.U. as well as the third, Jaguar Land Rover España, S.L. (hereinafter Land Rover).
